



Meal Ministry Update - from Becky Bavetz, Coordinator

*A special thank you to all who have provided meals to our church family over the past few months! We will now be utilizing an online tool called TakeThemAMeal to coordinate the delivery of meals. **If you would like to be a meal provider**, please give Becky Bavetz your email address.*

When we have a need for meals, she will set up the schedule and invite you via email to access the schedule. When you access the schedule, you will choose a date from the schedule to prepare a meal for the recipient. Type in your name, phone number, email address, and the meal you will be providing. The schedule page will include the recipient's name, address, preferred time to deliver the meal, allergies and how many persons in the household. The day before your designated meal delivery date, you will receive an email reminder.

If you do not have access to a computer or email address, you can still participate; let Becky know and she will contact you by phone. Please also notify Becky if you would like to be a delivery person for someone who is willing to make a meal but unable to deliver it.

Anyone in need of meals because of illness, hospitalization, new baby etc., please contact Andrea in the church office or Becky **contact church office** and provide your name, phone number, address, preferred time you would like the meals delivered to your home, number in household and any food allergies, etc.
