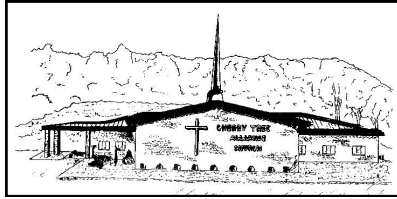

Al recently accepted the role of Assistant Vice President of Overseas Ministries for the C&MA. They ask for prayer in the following areas: *"We will be moving to Colorado Springs most likely at the end of July. We [returned] to Dakar, Senegal June 4-14 to sell our household items, pack, and say our good-byes.*

We covet your prayers for us as we say "good-bye" to a wonderful chapter in our lives. / Praise: Our family had a good visit back to Dakar in June and good closure as we transition back to the USA. We were able to close up our house, get rid of stuff we won't keep and bring back some personal items we wanted to keep. / Pray: 1. Al had the opportunity to share the Gospel with "D" on the trip to Senegal. Pray for the Holy Spirit's work in his life. 2. For our transition to Colorado Springs and all that needs to happen, like finding a house, etc. This move has been especially hard for our daughter Alexis. 3. For both Al & Lauralyn's parents who are facing physical challenges and sickness."



Scholarship Information for High School Seniors & College Students - Now Available!

We will be awarding scholarships this year at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee. Please note that high school seniors AND students currently enrolled in college (regardless of semester) are eligible to apply or reapply. Scholarships awarded by CTAC are open to students who have been active participants of Cherry Tree Alliance Church for at least one year (12 months), who have at least a 2.5 high school or college GPA, and a combined minimum score of 1200 on the SAT (or 1400 if third part of SAT was taken), or 19 on the ACT. Scholarships are provided by CTAC's "Student Fund / CMA Scholarship Fund." The deadline to apply is Sunday, **July 29th**.
