





International Worker of the Week

Please pray for our international worker of the week, Renee Valach,
currently serving in Gabon. She asks for prayer in the following areas:
"-We've been prevented from ordering certain medicines from our
principal suppliers. Currently we don't have any of the most common
oral diabetes medicine because of this problem. Other medicines are
running low. Pray that the problem would be resolved.
-There are several problems resulting in lack of obstetric care and
inability to do c-sections in the 3 south-central provinces, so that
maternity at Bongolo is too busy. Pray for resolution of these problems.
-Pray for another primary care doctor.
-Pray for a projects manager who can coordinate all the construction,
and infrastructure projects like electricity and water."

Scholarship Information for High School Seniors & College Students - Now Available!



We will be awarding scholarships this year at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee. Please note that high school seniors AND students currently enrolled in college (regardless of semester) are eligible to apply or reapply. Scholarships awarded by CTAC are open to students who have been active participants of Cherry Tree Alliance Church for at least one year (12 months), who have at least a 2.5 high school or college GPA, and a combined minimum score of 1200 on the SAT (or 1400 if third part of SAT was taken), or 19 on the ACT. Scholarships are provided by CTAC's "Student Fund / CMA Scholarship Fund." The deadline to apply is Sunday, **July 29th**.
