



JESUS IS ALIVE!

It's not an easy proposition.
Jesus died...but he lives.
The historical evidence for the crucifixion is overwhelming.
There can be no valid doubt that he was crucified and that he expired on that cross and that his body was placed in a tomb.

What about the resurrection?
Is it really possible that he came back from the dead?
Dare we believe that he lives?

Actually, the evidence is just as overwhelming for the resurrection as it is for the crucifixion.
There are multiple witnesses, all telling the same story.
They report seeing him,
talking to him,
eating with him,
receiving his instruction about what to do next,
assuring them
of his abiding presence.

And the truth of his resurrection is made the basis of genuine Christian faith.
You can't just say,
"Jesus was a good man"
or *"He was a great teacher."*
We are saved by our confession that he is Lord, and his Lordship is established by this:
The grave could not hold him!


