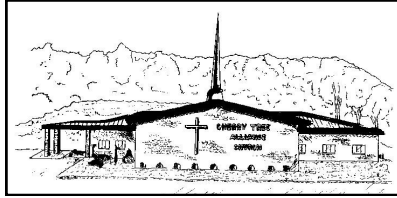

October - Personal Care Items (soaps, washcloths, combs, toothbrushes, hairbrushes, deodorant, hair ties & accessories)


November - Clothing & Handmade Items (hats, gloves, scarves, socks, shirts, pants / shorts, backpacks)
