

DISENFRANCHISED

By definition, those who are disenfranchised are forgotten, overlooked and neglected.

They don't count,
or they don't matter.

They are deemed to be *unimportant*.

To be disenfranchised means to be powerless, lacking in value or in significance, having no legal rights.

If you've ever felt that way, how good to know that *God is on your side!*

You matter to him!

In fact, he identifies with "the least of these."
He came to his own—
they refused him.

He was Lord of heaven—
and had no place on earth to lay his head.

So Jesus cautions us to be careful how we treat those who are despised by men.

See Matthew 25:31-46

That includes people with obvious needs, like the hungry and thirsty, outsiders and imprisoned, *the naked and the poor.*

Do we dare consider anyone to be "lesser" than ourselves when our Lord left glory to become like us in our sorrow and sin?



We request that every individual / family please submit an updated photo, as it has been several years since the original photos were taken. Our desire is to not only create a directory for the sake of sharing information, but to also connect our church family, both long-time and new attendees alike.

We thank you for your aid in helping our congregation match faces with names!

When taking or choosing your photo, we just ask that the image be taken in good light, be as clear as possible, and that the people primarily fill the frame. We typically crop directory photos so the faces are the focus. Photo size needs to be at least 1400 x 1024 (WxH in pixels). If you are unsure how to check the image size, feel free to submit your photo to ctallch@verizon.net and we can check for you. We are also able to take a photo for you if you prefer, or do a scan of a printed photo if you don't have a digital copy.
