
#### **Soul Sisters**

## INTERNATIONAL DAY OF PRAYER FOR THE PERSECUTED CHURCH

### BUDDHISM — "UNENLIGHTENED"

While Buddhism is more than 2,500 years old, its teachings have become more prominent globally in the last 50 years. Perceived by many to be a peaceful religion, in reality Buddhism is simply spiritual darkness.

In places like Nepal, the darkness of Buddhism is revealed as its followers work to appease spirits they know to be evil.

Buddhists also persecute Christians in their communities, and young adults who come to faith in Christ are driven from their homes. All of this is done explicitly to appease and court favor with evil spirits that we know to be demons — the fallen angels who, like their master, work only to steal, kill and destroy (John 10:10).

Please pray for our Christian brothers and sisters who are willing to pay any price to see Buddhists set free by the power of the gospel.

#### **International Workers of the Week**

Please pray for our Alliance workers of the week, Gary & Sharon Howell, who serve in Senegal. "Gary made a commitment to Christ at a young age in Sunday School. But it was during his early teen years, while reading Romans 2:4, that he realized God's patience and love for him and recommitted his life to Christ. His call to missions was confirmed during his short-term mission trips. Sharon grew up in Africa and had many opportunities to see her parents make a difference in the lives of the people in Gabon. At a young age, she realized that she needed to make a personal decision to follow Jesus. After serving for 24 years in Gabon and The Republic of Congo. Gary and Sharon felt God was calling them to consider a new calling to bring access to Jesus among the least-reached people in West Africa. In 2016 they moved to Dakar, Senegal, and began exploring ministry opportunities among Sahel people who were still largely untouched by the Gospel. Pray that the few believers among the Wolof and Fulani will boldly and courageously live out their faith and that many will come to Christ as a result. Pray that God would raise up and empower Godly leaders among the Wolof and Fulani for new churches and fellowships of believers. Pray for unity among the believers and the international workers who have been called to Senegal."
