Capital Campaign Launch

We are launching a capital campaign for a needed upcoming purchase of a new church van. Our current van has required more and more maintenance over the last several years,



and we are in need of additional transportation as the current van cannot hold our youth group. Our sincere hope is that a new church van can also be used by children & adult ministries as needed. We have ordered a new van for approximately \$65,000, which will take at least one year to arrive from the manufacturer. As we wait, we need to begin collecting funds for this expense. The dealership has agreed that if we do not have the needed funds when the van arrives, we do not have to take it; however, we want to avoid this as we would likely then have to go back on the waitlist for ordering a vehicle.

Pray for our newly developing team and growing refugee ministry – that God will knit us together in unity of spirit and purpose and that He will lead us in the ways we should go."
