KEY SCRIPTURES: Luke 1:1-21, John 3:16, & Isaiah 9:1-7

POINTS OF REFLECTION

- What is your favorite part of Christmas and why?
- What is the most memorable gift you have ever received? Why is it so memorable? What is the most memorable gift you have ever given? Why is it so memorable?
- Read Luke 1:1-21 and John 3:16 again. What stands out to you about Jesus' birth? How is His life special?
- What did God do so we could receive forgiveness for our sins?
- Why did God make a way for us to receive forgiveness? How can we receive this gift?
- Read Isaiah 9:6 again. In this passage Jesus is called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, and Prince of Peace. What do you notice about the key titles of the coming Messiah? In what ways do you see each name represented in who Jesus is?
- Jesus is the Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, and Prince of Peace. How does each of these impact your life?
- Our only reasonable response to God's gift to us is a life of worship. In what ways will you live this out?

ACTION STEPS

- Purposely spend time this week pressing into God. When you feel Him prompting you to take action, choose to be obedient.
- Commit to a step and live it out this week. What has God put on your heart after seeking him? How are you going to respond?
