#### A LIGHT IN THE DARKNESS

Recently, we were encouraged by a testimony from two of our ministry colleagues, Firmin and Veronique, a couple from the national church who serve at our orality center. They were trained to partner with international workers to plant churches through orality, an interactive storytelling technique that connects the Bible with many oral cultures, where people learn best through story. This outreach involves traveling to remote villages, and Firmin has been recovering from a motorcycle accident to one location that left him on crutches.

One evening, two military men knocked on the door of the center. The leader of the two was a sergeant in the army. He asked to see the pastor. Veronique was alone with the children. Understandably unnerved, she explained that Firmin wasn't there but offered to answer any questions.

The sergeant said, "Since you arrived in our village, there has been light where once it was dark. I've watched you from our military camp, and God has shown me that you are genuine. There is a light that shines from this place. I wondered what I could bring as a gift, but all I have

are these two cakes of soap. I brought them so the pastor can wash his clothes."

Veronique received the soap and told him, "The light that shines from here is not us. It is Jesus. You can have the same light in you." She continued to share with him from God's Word, and he listened with interest. The sergeant said that his wife attends church, but he never saw the point. Veronique invited him to return the next day for the service, and he did. It was a wonderful time with several testimonies of changed lives.

Recently, Firmin and Veronique had felt discouraged, wondering why it was so hard to see growth in their ministry, especially with hindrances such as motorcycle accidents. The sergeant's visit gave them hope that they are having an impact, even if they can't see it yet. The visit also encouraged us because we've had a burden to pray for breakthrough among those in the military camp. This experience affirmed that God is leading us in those prayers. Pray that these soldiers, who move frequently to other camps, will be drawn to Christ.
